**When does the conference start?**

The conference starts on October 7th at 9AM CDT.

**When does the conference end?**

The conference will conclude at 4:15PM CDT.

**I'm a speaker. When is my session?**

**As a vendor, do I get to give a pitch or a talk?**

Depends on your sponsorship level.

- Silver and above sponsors get time in the vendor room to make their pitch.
- Gold and above get time to present a vendor neutral talk.

**I'm giving a vendor pitch. What should I expect?**

We've set up a dedicated track called the "Vendor Room". Each vendor will get time in the spotlight to give their pitch or demo. Your time in the Vendor Room is available on the schedule here: <https://iwsokc.org/#schedule> Additionally, each vendor will have a dedicated Slack subchannel to engage attendees that will be available all day.

We'll be sending everyone their individualized Zoom invitations through an emailed calendar invitation. Please accept the invitation and let us know if you need anything. Make sure not to miss your speaking slot.

Vendor pitches will range from 30 minutes to 15 minutes each. We ask that you end your pitch with at least 3 - 4 minutes of Q&A so we can get ready for the next vendor.

**How do we engage the attendees?**

Aside from your scheduled talk and vendor pitch, you'll have access to the attendees via our Slack channel. Each vendor will have their own dedicated channel. Additionally, each track will also have its own dedicated channel.

Think of the Slack channel like a vendor booth. You'll want to make sure you have someone monitoring your channel (booth) and answering questions from the attendees.

### When will the Slack channel open up?

The Slack channel will open up on Monday, October 5th. Attendees, speakers, and vendors are welcome to join us then.

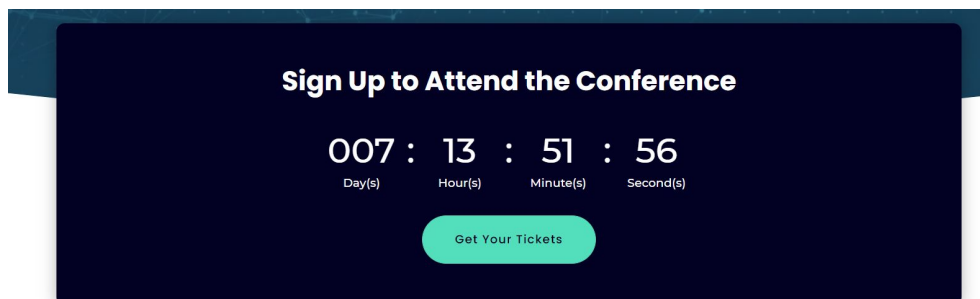
### I'm giving a talk. What should I expect?

All talks and pitches will be handled over a Zoom meeting and then streamed live to our website. In the meeting will be you and the IWS moderator. We'll manage the meeting for you and leave the presentation to you. We ask that you join the Zoom meeting 10 minutes before your scheduled talk. You'll be kept in the Waiting Room until the previous speaker has finished.

### Where will the talks be broadcast?

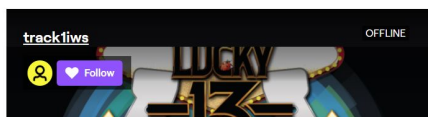

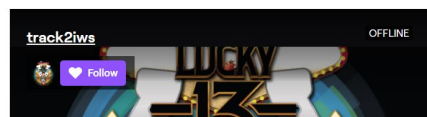
